California Citrus Nursery Society holds licenses for the following citrus varieties:

In a letter dated October 13, 2013, California Citrus Nursery Society authorized the Citrus Clonal Protection Program to maintain and register budwood source trees for these varieties in its facilities and to distribute budwood from these registered trees to sub-licensed citrus nurseries. California Citrus Nursery Society also provided the Citrus Clonal Protection Program with a list of sub-licensed citrus nurseries authorized to receive budwood of the above varieties.
